BOWLS ETIQUETTE

The lead in a team game or the opponent in a singles game should pick up the jack and hand it to their opponent at the start of an end. The first duty of the lead receiving the jack is to place the mat on the ground to indicate how far back the bowls should be rolled. Bowls should be placed at least one metre behind the mat and off centre to avoid possible injury should the bowler step back after delivering his/her bowl. It is customary to pick up the mat in any game whenever your opponent has delivered the last bowl of the end.

The bore, pipes and pump were cleaned during the week, unfortunately the pump has reached its use by date and whilst water flow has significantly increased we won't achieve maximum flow until the pump is replaced. A new pump has been ordered and should be installed in a week or so. The total cost will be a little more than our last water bill, however, all cleaning and repair costs will be fully recovered by the end of the year. The refurbished bore will more than meet our water needs on the green and the two new water tanks will cover all water used in and around the Club.
