### **MESSAGE FROM THE GREENKEEPERS**

We can all help keep our green in tip top condition by rotating rinks used for roll ups.

Note the wear beginning to show on rinks 3 and 4. By rotating rinks we can avoid unnecessary wear and tear, rotating rinks will also help maintain an even playing surface over the whole of the green. Avoid treading on ditch edges when stepping onto the green, step out a foot or so from the ditch. Do not drop/dump bowls on the green. Do not throw bowls from the bank onto the green, place them on the green.
